

Advantage Federal Credit Union 2019 College Scholarship Program

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship:

- Must be a current member of Advantage FCU with an account in their own name and members must be in good standing with Advantage FCU.
- All applicants must be a high school senior for the 2018/2019 school year.
- Must complete a Scholarship application and essay.
- Must plan to attend an accredited college or university in the 2019 school year.

Selection Process

The winners will be selected by an independent panel of judges responsible for evaluating and ranking applications received within three separate categories – Academic Performance, Community Involvement (includes sports, volunteer work and activities outside of the standard school curriculum) and an Essay Response. Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Application Process

To apply, student members must complete this scholarship application in full. Please attach one (1) additional sheet to your application containing your essay response and a copy of your Activities/Extra Curricular/Community Service Resume. Failure to complete the application and include all applicable attachments as instructed will result in disqualification.

- The signed application must be submitted to the address below, along with:
 - An official copy of the student's SAT and/or ACT scores (Please DO NOT send original)
 - An official copy of the student's high school transcript (SAT, ACT scores may be included on transcript)
 - Note: If required by the applicant's high school, this item can be mailed directly from the guidance office. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that their school transcripts have been submitted.
